**Change in Local Administrative Area Boundaries:** Due to the combination of the Garrard and Lincoln County offices, the local administrative area (LAA) boundaries for Garrard County have been re-drawn. This change has been accepted and approved by the Kentucky State FSA Committee. The new boundaries are shown on the area map. Highway 52 has been selected as the dividing line for the LAAs. Land which lies north of Highway 52 is LAA 4. Land which lies south of Highway 52 is LAA 5. Due to these changes, a transitional election will be held in both LAAs this year.


**Garrard County Elections:** Garrard County will be holding an election in each of the two LAAs this year. This is considered a transitional election due to changes in boundary. As part of this transitional election, the person elected to represent LAA 4 will serve a 2 year term, which will be considered a full term. The person elected to represent LAA 5 will serve a full 3 year term. After completion of this transitional election, all LAA terms will be 3 years.

LAA 4 will be holding an election for a representative from the area which is north of Highway 52. Some of the communities this includes are: Bryantsville, Buckeye, Buena Vista, Davistown, Hackley, Teatersville, Three Forks, and areas of Hyattsville, Point Leavell, and Lancaster.

LAA 5 will be holding an election for a representative from the area which is south of Highway 52. Some of the communities this includes are: Cartersville, Gilberts Creek, Flatwood, Harmony, Paint Lick, Sweeny, Wallacetown, and areas of Hyattsville, Point Leavell, and Lancaster.

**Lincoln County Election:** Lincoln County will be holding an election for a person to represent LAA 2. The position is currently being held by Joseph Stanley. LAA 2 includes land that is South of Highway 78 AND West of Highway 27. Some of the communities this includes are: Boneyville, Geneva, Highland, Kings Mountain, McKinney, Mount Salem, New Salem, South Fork, and parts of Hustonville and Waynesburg.
